Easter

*Dress Down Day is in the diary for Thursday 21st March for an Easter Egg donation. They will be used for prizes and hampers. Tara, Karen and Leanne will put the hampers together.

*Easter Bingo is all booked on Friday 5th April, 6pm until 8pm. Karen has printed the tickets. We need to order more bingo tickets. The cost will be £3 each per person with the option to upgrade on the night. Mrs Ward has will open Class 2 after school for refreshments. Tara, Karen, Leanne, Lisa, Cathy and Vicki will finalise set up from 5pm. Gav will arrive at school at 5.30 to be the bingo caller. We will have refreshments, tuck shop, tickets and dabber sales, prizes, BYO drink and cheese plates (2 for £5) A colouring table will be set up for the young children who are taking part. Lisa Dinsdale will be on the door selling extra bingo tickets. Bingo tickets will go on sale from Monday 1st April in the playground for one week only. We will need cheese plate orders when tickets are purchased.
