Our Governing Body believes that all children should attend school neatly and suitably dressed and expect pupils to wear the school colours – royal blue top with grey trousers/skirt – see highlighted items below. We ask that the children come to school in sensible flat black leather shoes. KS1 shoes should have either buckle (or Velcro) fastenings. Neither trainers nor boots are an acceptable form of footwear for normal classroom activities, and shoes should not have high heels. The advice of the School Medical Officer is that the wearing of high heels will affect the child's well-being and development.

- White polo shirts with school emblem.
- Blue Pique Dress
- Royal Blue draw-string bag for P.E.
- Royal Blue book bags with school emblem - no rucksacks please due to space
- Royal Blue school caps.

- Royal Blue woolly hats.
- Royal Blue showerproof jackets.

#### **PE UNIFORM**

Our PE kit consists of the following pack, all printed with the pupil's name: -

- Hoodie
- Jogging bottoms
- Shorts

- T shirt
- Trainers/plimsolls

#### **Please Note:**

- All pupils wear their trainers/plimsolls to school on PE day see newsletters.
- All pupils will need to keep a pair of plimsolls in school, in a drawstring bag, in case their other shoes become wet or muddy.
- KS1 will need to keep their plimsolls plus a change of clothes (shorts, socks, pants) in school

  in case of accidents.

#### Children taking part in swimming sessions will need the following: -

- The girls will need one-piece swimming costumes
- The boys swimming trunks please note that boys should wear trunks not shorts, for health and safety reasons
- Swim hat

This is in addition to their normal PE kit

If your child wishes to wear goggles you will need to complete an authorisation slip

## All belongings in school must clearly show the owner's name – we do not have a lost property box.

- Long hair should be tied back.
- Make-up and nail varnish must not be worn in school.
- We cannot take responsibility for valuable items, such as watches, which are brought into school.
- For health and safety reasons necklaces, chains and bracelets should not be worn, and only the smallest stud earrings are acceptable. Children must be able to insert and remove these on their own, because staff are not allowed to do this.
- No jewellery may be worn for P.E. Children who have their ears pierced should do so at the start of the summer break so that studs can be removed by the autumn.
- Each child needs black plimsolls with suitable T shirt and shorts for Physical Education.

<u>Please do not allow your child to bring valuable possessions into school</u> unless a special arrangement has been made with a member of staff.
