

Self-isolating: learning at home – Information for parents

If you are self-isolating but well enough to complete work and school is still open, please work through the maths and English lessons detailed below – 1 of each per day, and the rest of the work as described.

Maths

Access work on Oak National Academy on 'Securing multiplication facts' and 'Multiplication and Division' (year 4) and 'Deriving multiplication and division facts' (year 3) in maths.

English

In English, please work through the lessons on Oak National Academy on 'John Lyons poetry' (year 4) and 'Healthy Food, persuasive writing' (year 3).

There seems to be an issue with the links on the Oak Academy website, so unfortunately I cannot link them directly. Here is how to access the lessons:

- Go to the Oak National Academy website.
- Click subjects tab in top right hand corner, then show year groups, in blue near the top right of the page.
- Click your child's year group then access the subject you are looking for (English, maths, geography etc).
- Click on the units mentioned in the timetable.

Complete the All around me year 3 unit on Oak National Academy (RHE/PSHE)

Science

In science, please work through the 6 lessons on Human Anatomy (in year 4 section) on Oak National Academy.

Read your reading book for at least 15 minutes per day.
