**English**

Write a creative recipe for a new dream with an ingredients list and a method. Think about what you would like your dream to be about and therefore which ingredients you will need. Please do take your time on producing a well thought through piece of writing.

Please plan ingredients on day 1, writing which key ingredients in a list the order you'll add them, using varied amounts such as a dash of hope, a sprinkle of, 500g of, 2 heaped tbsps. of...

On day 2, draft your method – how are you making it and what will you add, when and how will it be combined with the rest of the ingredients? (mix, stir immediately, fold into the remaining mixture gently) Remember to use imperative verbs such as stir, mix and time conjunctions such as meanwhile and after that.

On day 3, check all of your writing for sense, a sensible order, correct key word spellings, exciting vocabulary, verbs and time conjunctions.

On day 4, rewrite your recipe with neat, partially joined handwriting and illustrate your work with one picture or a border of different pictures.

On day 5, write an acrostic poem with descriptive language about any character in, or the events of, 'The BFG', using the acrostic poster template uploaded below.
