Raising Funds-Community

Sponsored walk- Natalie has set up a sponsored walk for all children to walk 30 miles by 30th November- see email below sent 14th October-

As you know the last year and a half has been very difficult for everyone, and it has severely impacted our time together and fundraising opportunities. We have a couple of large projects within school that we have been asked to fundraise for this year – the first is new tablets/laptops, the current tablets are now out of date and as a result do not have all the programs that school would like to enhance our children's learning. We would also like to increase the number of tablets so that there is enough for 1 class, without the need for children to share. The second project is a Sail Shade for part of the back playground between class 1 and 2, this area is a sun trap and therefore a shade would provide greater protection to the children and allow

greater freedom to be outside in all weathers. In order to increase our fundraising we need to find ways to reach out to the wider community. Many of you will know that our children now do a session on Fridays call Future Fridays, so in keeping with this the PFA would like to set all the children a challenge. This years Climate Summit is being held in Glasgow during November, we would like to challenge each child to walk 30 miles (less than 1 mile per day) and get the whole school from Newton Burgoland to Glasgow by the 30th November and collect sponsorship along the way. We would love for the children to write messages of hope that we could then post to the Summit and also collect any litter they find when out on their walks. A prize will be offered to the child who walks the furthest in each year group and there will be a prize for most rubbish collected in one walk (so remember to map your walks and take photos of any rubbish you collect at the end of your walk).We really hope that you get involved with this fundraiser, perhaps get together with some friends to do your walks, explore some new places and have fun.
